




I wish you bad luck, again, from time to time so that you will be conscious of the role of chance in life and understand that your success is not completely deserved and that the failure of others is not completely deserved either.

And when you lose, as you will from time to time, I hope every now and then, your opponent will gloat over your failure. It is a way for you to understand the importance of sportsmanship.

I hope you'll be ignored so you'll know the importance of listening to others, and I hope you will have just enough pain to learn compassion.

Whether I wish these things or not, they're going to happen.

And whether you benefit from them or not will depend upon your ability to see the message in your misfortunes.

Train collides with road grader in fatal crash

A Goltry man died after the road grader he was driving was struck by a train in Alfalfa County Wednesday. Jimmy Wilson, 74, of Goltry was pronounced dead at the scene from internal injuries by Medical Examiner Brock Smith.

According to the Oklahoma Highway Patrol (OHP), Wilson was driving a 2018 John Deere Road Grader Model 672G north on County Rod 720 about 5:10 pm. Wednesday, May 16. The location is 24 feet south of Wheat Street in Goltry.

A Burlington Northern & Santa Fe train driven by Brett A. Curtis, 20, of Amarillo, Texas, was westbound on the railroad tracks. The OHP report says Wilson failed to yield and the road grader was struck by the train.

Neither Curtis nor his passenger Nathan Shaffer, 48, of Amarillo were injured. Wilson had to be extricated from his vehicle by Alfalfa County EMS.

Trooper Trey Mathews investigated assisted by Troopers Seth Sturgeon and Keven Edsall as well as the Alfalfa County Sheriff's Department.

Cherokee man has broken neck from wreck

A Cherokee man suffered a broken neck in an Alfalfa County wreck Monday. Ronal G. McMurtrey, 82, was transported by Alva EMS to Share Medical in Alva and then transferred to OU Medical in Oklahoma City. He was admitted in stable condition with a broken neck.

The accident occurred at 10:30 a.m. May 21 on County Road 550, three-tenths of a mile south of Greer Road. The location is approximately four miles west and three miles south of Ingersoll.

The Oklahoma Highway Patrol says McMurtrey was driving a 1997 Ford pickup north on County Road 550 when the front driver-side wheel and tire came off. The vehicle left the road, entered the west ditch and rolled one time.

Trooper Robert Cottrill of the Garfield County detachment investigated the scene.

Two Tyrone residents killed in Kansas crash

One was NWOSU student

SEWARD COUNTY, Kansas – A Northwestern Oklahoma State University student and a teen from Tyrone lost their lives in a Kansas crash early Sunday morning. Three other people were taken to the hospital.

The crash happened around 1:15 a.m. May 20 at the intersection of US-54 and Blue Bell Road in Liberal, Kansas.

According to the Kansas Highway Patrol, a 1999 Dodge Durango driven by Rojelio V. Campa, 18, Liberal, was westbound on Bluebell Road when he failed to stop at the end of the dead end road, ran over a concrete curb and entered a divider designed to prevent traffic from entering onto US-54. As the SUV traveled across the divider, it impacted a large boulder and exited onto US-54.

The front of the SUV struck the passenger side of a northwest bound 1995 BMW driven by Caleb

C. Olson of Tyrone. Passengers in Olson's vehicle were Austin K. Olson, 18, of Collinsville; Tyler M Olson, 20, of Tyrone, and Conner L. Smith, 20, of Tyrone.

All five people involved were transported to the hospital in Liberal. Austin Olson and Conner Smith died as a result of the collision. Conner Smith was a student at NWOSU in Alva, and sources say Austin Olson was planning to attend NWOSU.

Funeral services for both young men have been set for Friday at 10:30 a.m. in the Tyrone School Gym.





Voter registration deadline is June 1

Friday, June 1, is the last day to apply for voter registration in order to be eligible to vote in the June 26 primary election, Alfalfa County Election Board Secretary Kelly Stein said today.

Stein said that persons who are United States citizens, residents of Oklahoma, and at least 18 years old may apply to become registered voters.

Those who aren't registered or need to change their registration may apply by filling out and mailing an Oklahoma Voter Registration Application form in time for it to be postmarked no later than midnight Friday, June 1.

Stein said applications postmarked after that time will be accepted and processed, but not until after June 26.

The county election board responds in writing to every person who submits an application for voter registration. The response is either a voter identification card listing the new voter's precinct number and polling place location or a

Kiowa City Council locks in energy prices, calls for July 10 election on term limits

Swimming pool to open Memorial Day, May 28

The May meeting of Kiowa’s City Council had a full agenda and lasted over three hours. Mayor Ron Rohr was ill so council president Bill Watson conducted the meeting. Councilmember R.L. Simpson joined the meeting by telephone. All other members attended: Russ Molz, Brian Hill and Tom Wells. City Administrator Lou Leone sat at council table as did City Attorney Laurel McClellan and City Clerk Trish Brewer. Numerous people sat in the audience section.

At the council’s February meeting they voted to do away with term limits by approving Ordinance 18-018. The vote was 4-2 with Hill and Mayor Rohr voting no as they wished to keep term limits. City Administrator Leone placed this issue on the February agenda as he said the matter had come up several times. He gave several examples of why he thought council should not have term limits, such as fewer and fewer people even file to run for a position.

Since that meeting petitions were circulated around Kiowa to get signatures from those in favor of term limits. After meeting all the legal requirements, the petitions were addressed by the council.

The results are the call for a July 10 election for the voters in Kiowa to decide whether they want term limits for their elected positions of mayor and city council members. The council voted 5-0 in favor of the election. Leone said the estimated cost of a special election will be \$3500 or under.

Council Locks in Future Energy Capacity and Price

At the recommendation of Leone, the council unanimously approved Resolution 18-287, which gives the mayor authority to sign a contract with the Kansas Municipal Energy Agency (KMEA), effective June 1. This is a purchase agreement to lock in price and capacity of the city’s electric production they purchase through KMEA.

The city currently purchases electricity through KMEA with the current agreement expiring in 2020 and the existing price continues until then. With this new contract renewal beginning in January 2021, through KMEA power will be purchased from NextEra Energy Marketing LLC. This is how the better energy price and capacity locks in with the city for six years starting in 2021.

The council approved two contracts that lock in energy prices for peak and off-peak times. The city currently pays .03385/megawatt for off-peak time. With the new prices they’ll pay .02572 off-peak; and .03345 for peak.

Simpson told the administrator he wants to insure if Kiowa grows, they won’t have to purchase too much energy on the open market at a higher price.

Leone said this move will potentially help reduce property tax and also keep the city from needing to raise electric rates.

Barber County United To Help People Help Themselves

Kiowa woman Donna Williams spoke to the council about Barber County United. It consists a group of 30 individuals from north and south Barber County working together to improve the quality of living for the people.

A county-wide health needs survey

last year revealed a need for mental health awareness and prevention. That includes depression, suicide, alcohol abuse and more for all ages.

Williams said the group started with the Friends of the Kiowa Hospital and Manor Foundation. Barber County United applied for and received a \$254,000 grant to be used over a three-year period. The group is applying for not-for-profit status.

The group wants to network with all resources such as: churches, ministerial alliance, Shriners, Masons, Lion’s Club and other groups to help. Barber County United plans to mentor people through their Circles Program. For example, to teach individuals how to interview and hold a job.

“Our vision is to help people,” Williams said. “We want to help people help themselves.”

Barber County United wants to have an office open within 60 days. Williams told the council she would like one of them to represent the city at their next meeting. It is June 7 at 10:30a.m., at Grace Bible Fellowship in Kiowa. The meetings alternate between Medicine Lodge and Kiowa.

City Building Update

Brewer explained details of the building committee’s plan for renovating the existing city building with the Terwort building next door for a larger city hall and police department.

The building committee and council planned a special meeting to further look at the project. At that meeting the council approved adding Kem Humphrey and Christiana Duvall to the building committee.

Also at that meeting, in executive session, council reviewed applications for a police chief, Leone said. Background checks will be conducted on some of the applicants, he confirmed.

Administrator Shows Videos on Council Quorums and Police Department

Leone had on the agenda a “Mini-Training: Review of Topics from the League.” The administrator specified open meeting laws to the council and advised them to be careful about a quorum of members beyond council meetings

Two charged with bringing drugs into JCCC

Two women accused of bringing contraband into James Crabtree Correctional Center (JCCC), Helena, are charged with felonies in Alfalfa County.

According to court records, on Feb. 20 an official at JCCC observed visitor Kristy Barnett kissing inmate Renel Brewer. The inmate was seen putting his hand down the back of her pants, pulling out something and placing it in his pants.

Brewer was removed from the visiting area and placed in a holding cell for a strip search. When asked to open his mouth, Brewer was seen trying to swallow something. When he couldn't swallow it, he spit the item out. The item field tested positive for methamphetamine. When weighed, the item was 13 grams.

When questioned, Barnett said Brewer called her from a cellphone inside JCCC and asked her to meet someone called Little D. She described the man she met at a convenience store in Oklahoma City. The man gave her a package wrapped in black tape.

On May 16, Kristy Barnett, 44, of Grand Prairie, Texas, was charged with bringing contraband drugs into a penal institution, a felony. A warrant has been issued for her arrest.

In the second case court records show on April 30 an officer supervising visitation at JCCC reported inmate Michael Riley possibly had contraband. Riley was removed from the visiting area and placed in a holding cell where he was told to hand over the contraband. He said it was in his rectum and retrieved it for the officer. It was found to contain two

ounces of marijuana and six cigarettes.

In a recorded post-Miranda interview, Harper said she received a text that Riley's medicine was on her porch. She would not disclose the number the text came from. Harper said she retrieved the contraband and drove to JCCC on visiting day April 30 where she gave the contraband to Riley.

Harper said she has brought contraband to Riley while he was an inmate at Joseph Harp Correctional Center in Lexington and at JCCC.

On May 16, Margo Ann Harper, 55, of Lexington, was charged with bringing contraband drugs into a penal institution. This crime is punishable by imprisonment in the state penitentiary for one to five year, or a fine of \$100 to \$1,000, or both such fine and imprisonment.

Voters should apply early for absentee ballots

Voters in Alfalfa County who want to have absentee ballots mailed to them for the June 26 primary election should apply now, County Election Board Secretary Kelly Stein said today. Although the county election board can accept applications for absentee ballots until 5 p.m. on Wednesday, June 20, Stein urged voters who want to vote by absentee ballot to apply early.

Absentee ballot application forms are available at the county election board office located at 602 W. 5th St., Cherokee. An online version of the form can be filled out and submitted electronically at www.elections.ok.gov. A print form can also be downloaded at that address.

Ballots must be in the hands of county election board officials by 7 p.m. on election day to be counted.

Stein said any registered voter may vote by absentee ballot in any election in which he/she is eligible to vote. However, a voter must be registered and reside at an address within the geographical boundaries of a school district or a municipality to be eligible to vote in school district or municipal elections. It is not necessary to give a reason for voting absentee.

"While anyone can vote absentee without giving a reason, the law still provides several advantages to absentee voters in some categories," Stein said.

By stating one of the following reasons on their applications, absentee voters can activate special conditions that make it easier for them to use absentee ballots. The reasons are:

- Voters who are physically incapacitated and voters who care for physically incapacitated persons who cannot be left unattended may vote absentee. They may apply only by mail, fax, email, online or via an agent who is at least 16 years of age and who is not employed by or related within the third





degree of consanguinity or affinity to any person whose name appears on the ballot.

- Voters who are confined to nursing homes in the county may vote absentee. An absentee voting board actually goes to the nursing home a few days before the election, sets up a small polling place and allows these persons to vote under circumstances similar to those at a regular precinct polling place. They may apply only by mail, fax, email, online or via an agent who is at least 16 years of age and who is not employed by or related within the third degree of consanguinity or affinity to any person whose name appears on the ballot.

- Military personnel and residents of the county living overseas and the spouses and dependents of each group are eligible receive absentee ballots. These voters may apply only by mail, fax or email. Military personnel should contact the voting service officers in their units for application forms and additional information or visit the Federal Voting Assistance Program website (www.fvap.gov/oklahoma) for more information and instructions. Residents of Oklahoma living overseas can obtain the same materials from any United States military installation and from United States Embassies and Consulates as well as on the FVAP website.



when out in the community.

He also reminded them not to discuss council business outside meetings. “Your voice is at this council meeting. You need to not talk about the meeting outside chambers.” He added, “We need to work together.”

He told the council that as city administrator he has no hire/fire ability. A city manager can hire and fire, Leone said and added in that scenario “the mayor has a more ceremonial role.”

The next video Leone played was of the police department building on the east edge of Kiowa and the state of disarray it was in last February when he reportedly took this video. Files were strewn throughout the office as were piles of trash, guns were not locked up and more.

“My goal is not to embarrass anyone, it’s to show the broken chain of command we have,” Leone said. He said a chain of command is needed to avoid situations like this. Of the police department, Leone said, “They didn’t report to anyone.”

Leone also showed a video of the Kiowa School Museum that is in “bad shape.” He suggested the cherished school memorabilia be displayed in the new city office. “We are still paying insurance on a building that should be condemned.”

City Administrator Reports Pool to Open Memorial Day and More Items

Although the pool house won’t be ready to open, Leone assures swimmers the swimming pool will open Memorial Day. He said they are making an entrance through the fence to access the pool.

The library roof is finished and looks good, he said.

Leone confirmed there were problems with the new generator. There was water in the fuel. He said that Foley (the generator people) are coming to replace the heads on the generator.

Leone requested an official proclamation declaring May 20-26 as Public Works Week to recognize the city crew.

The city received a \$9,000 reimbursement check from EMC insurance company which goes in the general fund.

Longtime Kiowa resident and retired business owner Bob Hays who is an integral part of the Chamber of Commerce, gave the city \$6,352 for 18

new aluminum tables and a carrier for the Community Building. Council members expressed their appreciation.

Leone began to share some issues he has with the mayor. Watson stopped him and said that conversation should be moved to executive session.

More Kiowa Council Business

Regarding the city’s Blue Cross/Blue Shield health insurance for employees, Leone said the renewal is an increase of 12.5 percent. Despite the increase, council voted to stay with the existing plan as the city has a “grandfathered” status which they want to keep regarding deductibles and more.

Mayor Rohr’s list of annual appointments was approved by council: Municipal Judge – Rich Befort; City Attorney – Laurel McClellan; Treasurer – Rex Zimmerman; City Clerk – Trish Brewer; Fire Chief – Bill Duvall; Assistant Fire Chief – Roger Robison.

Following executive session at the end of the meeting, council put city crew employee Ronnie McKitrick in charge of city code enforcement and animal control.

Leone has visited Becky Buckle’s third grade class at the elementary school teaching them about government and the rights guaranteed to every citizen. When he asked what they’d like the city council to do for the students they suggested a trampoline park.




